### 1. Atlantis The Palm Nasimi Beach / White Beach

Location: Palm Jumeirah

Access: Hotel guests or day pass (via White Beach)

Atlantis White Beach Club is a luxury beachfront venue offering infinity pools, lounge beds, and private cabanas. The beach is pristine, well-maintained, and has incredible views of the Dubai skyline.

How to Access:

- Book a stay at Atlantis The Palm
- Buy a day pass to White Beach (starting from AED 150300 depending on the day)

Why Its Special:

World-class service, live DJs, beachfront dining, and access to the hotels amenities like Aquaventure Waterpark.

## 2. Burj Al Arab Jumeirah Beach Hotel (J Club)

Location: Umm Suqeim

Access: J Club day pass or stay at a Jumeirah hotel

This is one of Dubais most iconic luxury destinations. The private beach area offers views of the Burj Al Arab, shaded loungers, towel service, and even cold water mists to cool off during summer.

Day Pass Cost: AED 250350

Access Includes: Pool, beach, gym, and spa facilities

Why Its Worth It:

Its a true five-star experience with fewer crowds and top-tier hospitality. Perfect for couples or solo

travelers seeking tranquility.

### 3. Nikki Beach Dubai

Location: Pearl Jumeirah

Access: Day pass, hotel guests, or restaurant reservation

Nikki Beach is known for its chic vibes, international DJ sets, and beachfront luxury. Its more of a beach club than a quiet retreat, so expect music and a lively crowd.

Day Pass Range: AED 200-300 (redeemable against food & drink)
